Statement on the Attack on Babyn Yar

Along with the Association of Holocaust Organizations, the South Carolina Council on the Holocaust joins the world in strongly condemning the missile attack damaging the Babyn Yar memorial site built to honor the memory of the Jewish victims of the Holocaust who were murdered at Babyn Yar. Eighty years after the mass killings of an estimated 34,000 innocent Jewish victims on this site, and with antisemitism, xenophobia and other forms of hate on the rise around the world, it is more important than ever to preserve sites of memory like Babyn Yar.
